## Getting Credit for Plato Assignments

- Each assignment has **3 parts: tutorial, application(s), and mastery test(s)**.
- You must **complete all 3 parts** and **score at least 80%** (8/10 or 4/5) on all mastery tests to earn full credit (10 points).
- You may **retake the mastery tests** as many times as you like before the due date if you do not earn at least 80%.
- You may **work ahead** if you like. In other words, you do not have to wait until an assignment has been scored to begin working on the next assignment.

## Unlocking a Mastery Test

- If you get locked out of a mastery test, **launch the tutorial again**. This should unlock the mastery test.
- If not, ask a staff member in the Student Success Lab in SS143 for help or email Kim Knickell at [knickell@bakersfieldcollege.edu](mailto:knickell@bakersfieldcollege.edu) (Tell her that you are a student in Ms. Cason's ACDV B61/80 class and tell her which assignment you're having trouble with.)

## Technical Problems

- Plato generally doesn't work on a cell phone and some tablets.

- Plato will work on any computer on campus, so if you cannot access it from home, you may have to complete your assignments at school.
